- · Maximizing margins when batting first
- Avoiding heavy defeats that damage NRR

As the season nears its conclusion, NRR calculations often become as important as points themselves, adding another layer of drama to the standings.

Star Performers Shaping the Standings

Individual brilliance continues to influence the BPL 2025–26 points table. While T20 cricket is a team game, standout performances can swing momentum and elevate teams in the standings.

Key contributions include:

- Top-order batters delivering consistent powerplay starts
